As his killings of the two other women were both women he was romantically involved with, and as far as we could determine, he had no relationship with Marjorie and no motive to kill her, he was excluded from the investigation.

Autopsy Summary
 Body was badly decomposed but the cause of death was determined to be ligature strangulation.

Physical Evidence
 The deceased was dressed in what appeared to be a green dress and black shoes. A pair of tights were discovered around the neck, and she was wearing a gold chain and a gold ruby ring.

Last Know Movements/Sightings
 She left home at 6:30 PM to meet friends at The Swan Pub in Wotton under Hill. She said she would return home by 1 AM after celebrating the New Year. A witness came forward, Miss Martha Fisher, a coworker and friend. She was celebrating with Joanne but said that at 11:30, Joanne left, stating she was heading home because she felt a little unwell. Joanne never arrived home. Joanne was confirmed to be wearing a green dress and gold jewelry, including a family heirloom ruby ring on her finger.

Suspects/Persons of Interest
 At the time, there were no suspects. Joanne was not known to be in a relationship. Later, Terrence was arrested and charged with the murder of Georgina. During his confession, he admitted to also killing Joanne, with whom he had been in a relationship, but she had broken it off just days prior to her murder.

Autopsy Summary
 Body was badly decomposed but the cause of death was determined to be ligature strangulation.

Physical Evidence
 The deceased was found wearing remnants of a nurse uniform, with a pair of tights around the neck. Additionally, she was wearing a cross necklace and earrings.

Last Know Movements/Sightings
 She left home at 7:30 PM to meet friends at the Royal Oak Inn and said she would return home by 11:30 PM. A witness came forward, Robert Frederick, who believed he saw the victim walking through Garenton Park at around 7:45 PM with an older man, approximately 40 to 50 years old, with graying hair, approximately 6 feet tall, and wearing a brown suit. This sighting was confirmed by a friend of Georgina who stated she was seeing an older man she referred to as "Terry" who matched the description.

Suspects/Persons of Interest
 Terrence Dawkins is the PRIME SUSPECT. At the time, he was romantically involved with the victim. He was initially questioned, but he claimed that Georgina told him she was leaving to start a new life in Ireland. The family received communication in the form of letters, so the missing person inquiry was not pursued.
